


CCS NICU High Risk Infant Follow-up (HRIF) Eligible Infants Referral Guidelines

CPQCC recommends that eligible infants be <u>referred to HRIF within 60-days</u> of being discharged to home from the NICU.



- Infants discharged to home in January February, should be referred before April
- Infants discharged to home in March April, should be referred before June
- Infants discharged to home in May June, should be referred before August
- Infants discharged to home in July August, should be referred before October
- Infants discharged to home in September October, should be referred before December
- Infants discharged to home in November December, should be referred by February (new year)

3RD QUARTER EXPECTATION = Infants discharged to home between January – July, should be referred and linked to a HRIF record.

1st **QUARTER EXPECTATION =** Infants discharged to home between August – February (*new year*) should be referred and linked to a HRIF record.

- Any Still in Hospital (SIH) infants, should be registered once identified as eligible for HRIF.
- All infants born in the year must be registered in the HRIF Reporting System by the June 1st deadline.
- NICU Closeout Checklist (item #13) must be 100% by the data finalization deadline.
