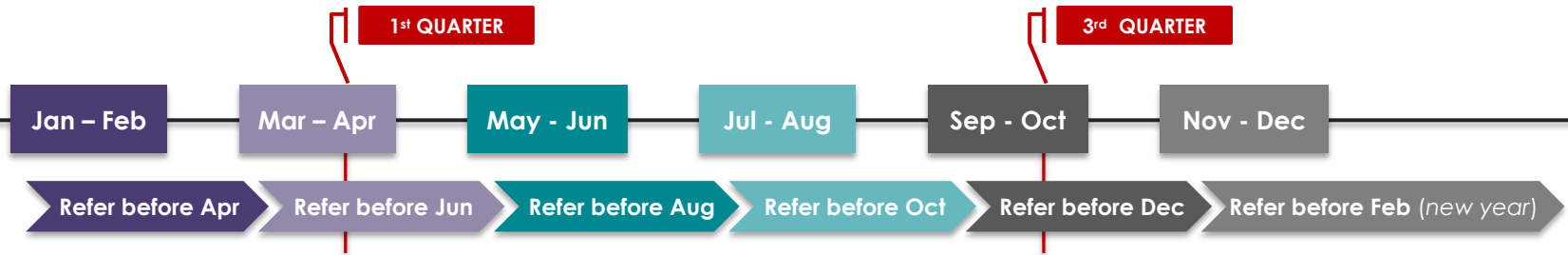


# CCS NICU High Risk Infant Follow-up (HRIF) Eligible Infants Referral Guidelines

CPQCC recommends that eligible infants be referred to HRIF within 60-days of being discharged to home from the NICU.



- Infants discharged to home in January - February, should be referred before April
- Infants discharged to home in March - April, should be referred before June
- Infants discharged to home in May - June, should be referred before August
- Infants discharged to home in July - August, should be referred before October
- Infants discharged to home in September - October, should be referred before December
- Infants discharged to home in November - December, should be referred by February (*new year*)

**3<sup>RD</sup> QUARTER EXPECTATION =** Infants discharged to home between January – July, should be referred and linked to a HRIF record.

**1<sup>ST</sup> QUARTER EXPECTATION =** Infants discharged to home between August – February (*new year*) should be referred and linked to a HRIF record.

- Any Still in Hospital (SIH) infants, should be registered once identified as eligible for HRIF.
- All infants born in the year must be registered in the HRIF Reporting System by the June 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.
- NICU Closeout Checklist (item #13) must be 100% by the data finalization deadline.
